My name is Joji Abraham, and my Business Partner name is Shyju Varghese, we are the owners of JMS ONE INC located at 115 E Green St, Bensenville IL 60106 We are running a small van rental business since 2017. We are one of the smallest rental company in the city of Bensenville. We have another location in Berwyn IL and one in Deerfield IL. We have a total of 21 Vans in all locations.

By Illinois law Car/Van rental company's falls under

Illinois Automobile Renting Occupation and Use Tax

Even though we are the legal owners of the vehicle, we don't use this vehicle. Our customers use this vehicle for the personal or Business needs, and we collect tax from them based upon final sale amount and We are paying monthly tax to the state of Illinois and the city of Bensenville based on the Total sale amount per transaction. City of Bensenville is getting 1% of the total sales. Until November 2019 we collected \$3793 from our customer for the city of Bensenville. State of Illinois Cap maximum 1% tax on village and township taxing rental companies. When we sell these vehicles, we also need to collect the sale tax like a car dealership.

Even though we are a very small business, our business indirectly supports the local gas stations at York St and Green St. All rentals vehicles supposed to be return with same amount of fuel at pick up. So, most of the customers use the gas stations nearby. So, it's a Support for the local business and the village.

On 12/06/2019 we received 15 warning notice and 2 ticket for \$50 each in our vehicle, parked in our parking lot not having the "Annul Vehicle Tax Sticker" on our vehicles. Unlike any other business vehicles registered in the city of Bensenville, even though we own the registered owners of the vehicles, but we

are not the users of the vehicle. From the real users collect \$3793 so far this year for the city of Bensenville and paid. This is a double taxation for small business like us.

If you read the Village of Bensenville Code, you can see that village exempt vehicles with Apportioned plates not to have village stickers in their vehicles because, they are paying tax to the state and the city where they use. Like Apportioned plates vehicles, we pay the tax based on our sale receipt. Like any store selling a product in Bensenville, Our Vehicles are our products like products in any store. When we sell the product to public, we are happy to collect the tax from our customers. But village cannot force us to have another tax on our product, while we are keeping in it in our shelf, waiting for the customer to come and pick up. That is totally unfair for a small business. Our vehicles are not using any city roads or infrastructure while sitting in out lots.

For Example: HVAC Mechanic who owns a truck, use his truck to go to customers house. He won't charge the customer anything separates for the use of truck, but his total bill to the customer includes the use of the truck for customers need. He is not paying any fax or fee other than village of Bensenville other than the Annul village sticker for \$30. But so far this year we paid an average of \$180/truck which is 6 times more than the village sticker price. If you look the big car rental companies in Bensenville or nearby cities, 2 in York Road in Elmhurst you won't see any village stickers in their vehicles. More over their vehicles are parked in Gated property. No police and village won't show the courage to give citation to those big companies the same way when Uber and Lyft run taxi service without any License. On 12/16/2019 there are 6 other vehicles from other company's parked in the same building parking lot where our vehicles parked. We didn't see a ticket in those vehicles. I don't know why the police department didn't see those vehicles without a city sticker parked overnight. This shows that city of Bensenville just targets our business alone, who pay tax to the city in a regular basis and ignore other business who pays no tax for using the vehicle in Bensenville.

By this letter we are requesting the village board to study the facts we mentioned in this letter and exempt our business from buying any village sticker for keeping the vehicle in our parking lot, while holding the vehicles before the customers pick up.
