3. Village Attorney, Peter Ostling, Village Manager, James Johnson, and Assistant Village Manager for Management Services, Thomas Truty, summarized the action contemplated in **Resolution No. R-2-2006**, entitled **A Resolution Providing for and Requiring the Submission of the Question "SHALL THE VILLAGE OF BENSENVILLE, DUPAGE AND COOK COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, IMPOSE A NON-HOME RULE MUNICIPAL RETAILERS' OCCUPATION TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE PERCENT (1%) AND A NON-HOME RULE MUNICIPAL SERVICE OCCUPATION TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE PERCENT (1%), FOR EXPENDITURE ON PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE OR FOR PROPERTY TAX RELIEF OR BOTH?"** to the Electors of the Village of Bensenville, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, at the General Primary Election to be Held on the 21<sup>st</sup> Day of March, 2006.
