## Village President Frank DeSimone Issues Executive Order to Offer Relief to Residents and Businesses

**Bensenville, IL** – As COVID-19 continues to impact the community, Village President Frank DeSimone has issued an executive order in an effort to further reduce COVID-19 impacts in Bensenville. This executive order also serves as a reminder that the State of Illinois has issued a stay at home order for all Illinois residents.

The Village's executive order includes:

- Temporarily suspending service disconnections for water and refuse.
- Temporarily suspending overnight street parking restrictions.
- Door-to-Door solicitation licenses are temporarily revoked and new licenses will not be issued during this time.
- Building permit expiration dates may be extended for ninety (90) days if requested by the permit holder. Fees for extensions are also suspended.
- Administrative adjudication for red light camera tickets, parking, equipment, and non-moving citations set to be heard in April and May will be continued to June 18. Vehicle tow, seizure, and impound hearings set to be heard in April and May are continued to June 11. No additional fees or penalty's will be assessed due to this change.
- Administrative adjudication of all other Village ordinance violations set to be heard in April and May will be continued to June 11. No additional fees or penalty's will be assessed due to this change.
- Village playgrounds, sport courts, and athletic fields are closed. Walking, jogging, and biking paths will remain open, but users must practice social distancing. Restroom facilities will remain closed during this time.
