

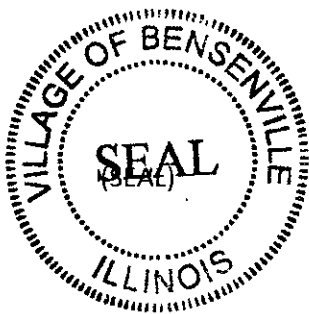

**Lawsuit: Reproductive Health Act's insurance mandate violates religious freedoms**

Insurance provisions of Illinois' reproductive health care law violates residents' religious freedoms, a coalition of Baptist churches and two state businesses allege in a circuit court lawsuit filed June 10.

The Reproductive Health Act, signed into law by Gov. JB Pritzker almost one year ago, overhauled Illinois' health care law. It enshrines access to pregnancy care, contraception, birth control, abortion procedures and other related benefits as a fundamental right, meaning no level

of government in the state can infringe upon a person's access to those services.

In its lawsuit, the Thomas More Society, a Chicago law firm that focuses on defending religious rights, took issue with the statute's insurance mandate—that private insurance companies regulated by Illinois must cover abortions if they also cover pregnancy-related benefits.

By enforcing that provision, the state Department of Insurance has "refused to protect [Illinoisans'] sincerely-held religious beliefs," according to a news release.
